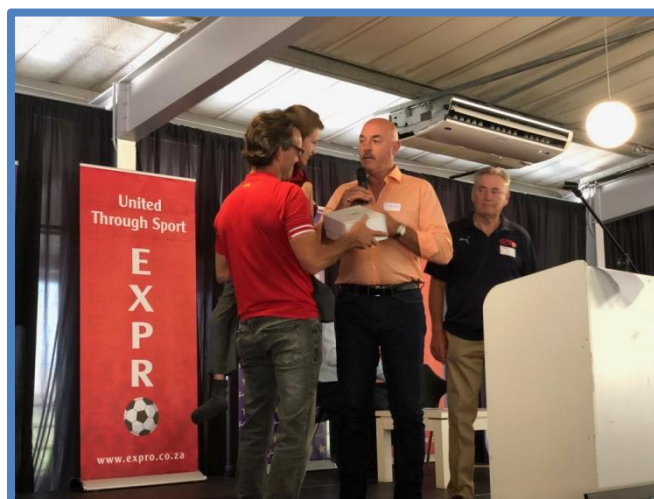
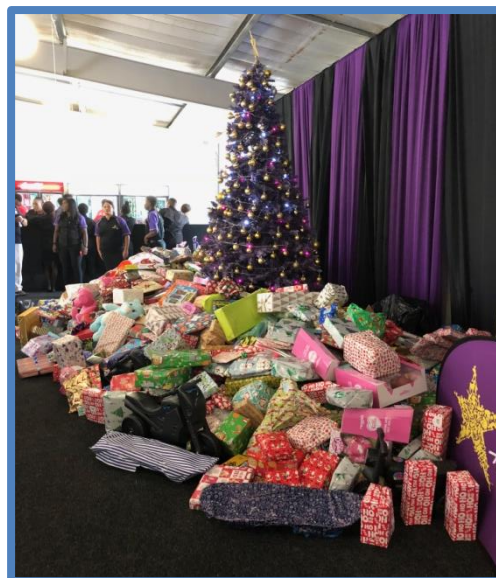

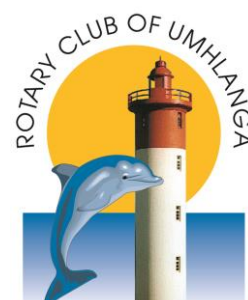
EXPRO LUNCH 2018
