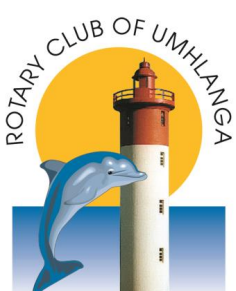




Fine conditions greeted the capacity field that took to the immaculate course at Mount Edgecombe country Club...

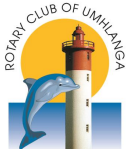

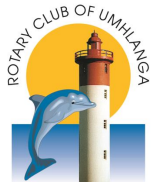
