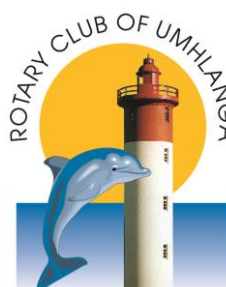


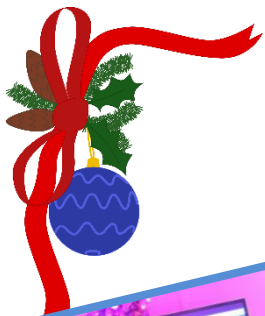
Toy Handover 2020

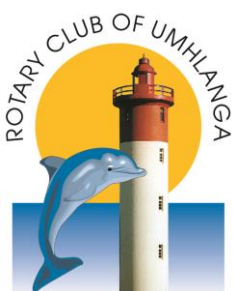






TPA Humanity/Food For Life recently hosted members of Rotary Club of Umhlanga for a hands on day of preparing meals for distribution in the Durban area.

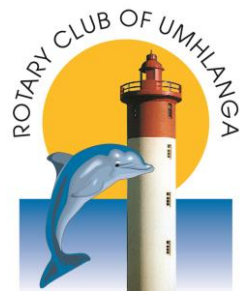

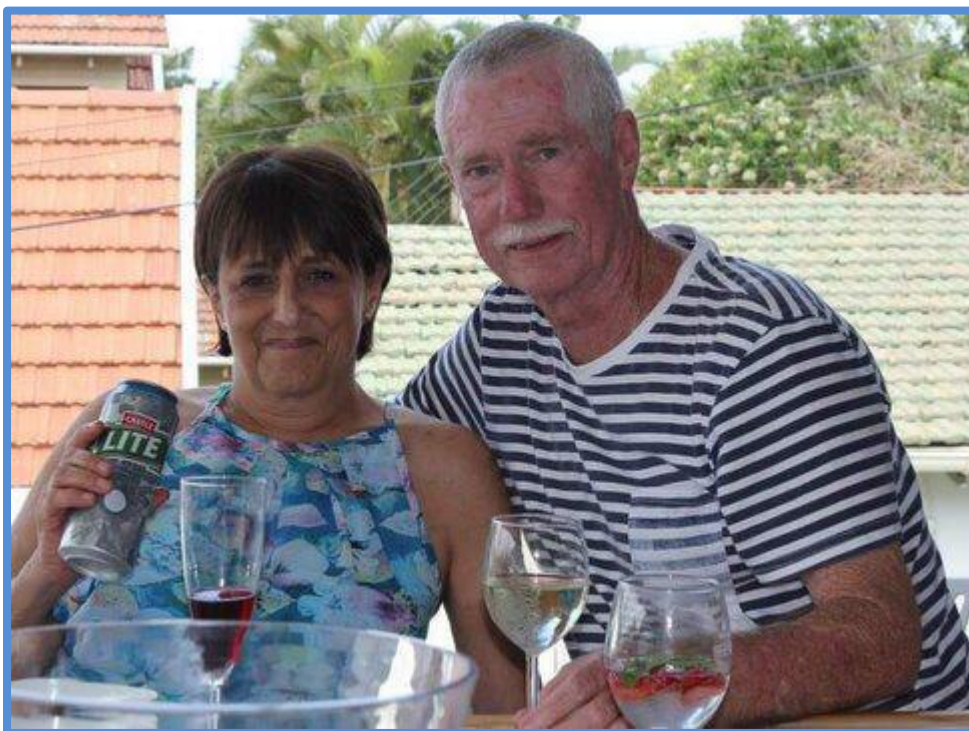


***(above)* A different type of “bean counting”, Kevin and Cohan try their hand at preparing beans for the pot...**

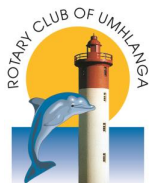
