

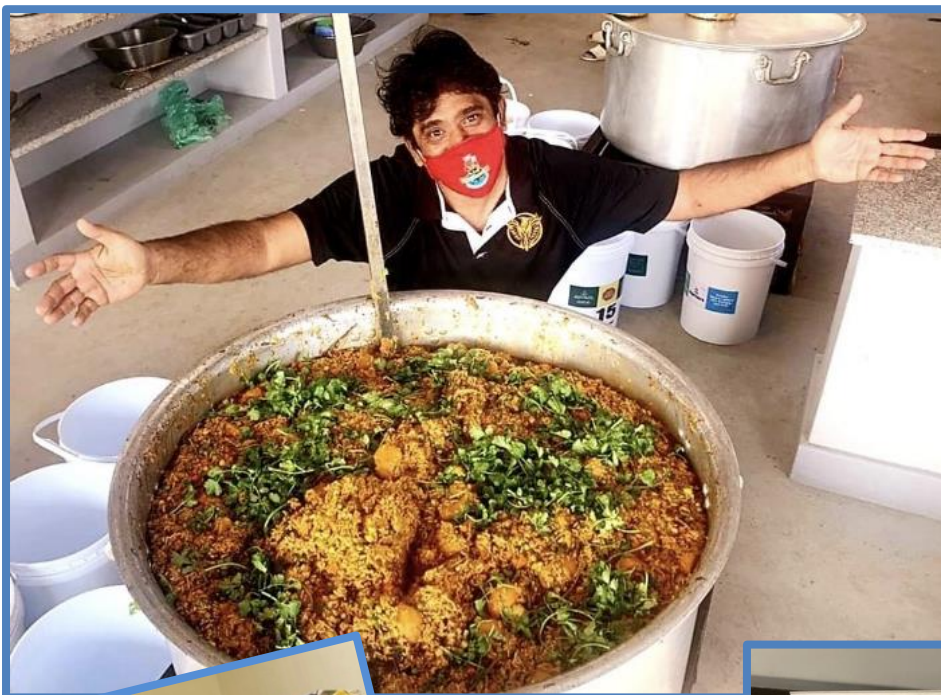
## Rotary Club of Umhlanga members assist to feed the needy with TPA Humanity and Food for Life
