The Sinevuso School / Woza Moya Project

Rotarian Kerry Moss recently visited the Sinevuso School / Woza Moya Project, in the heart of the Ofafa Valley. The project began in 2000 to provide home based health care in response to the devastating impact of HIV/Aids. The valley suffers from high unemployment and deep poverty, as a result many families don't have enough food. Woza Moya's Food Security Program includes farming projects (vegetables, eggs, milk and meat from chickens and goats), income generating handcraft projects (hand embroidery, card making, knitting, bag making and Sock Monkeys), and self-help projects. The aim is to provide sustainable means for the families to have access to food and goods. This holistic and integrated approach now includes child care and protection, early childhood development, paralegal, advocacy and youth development. Over the years, Woza Moya has been supported by the Rotary Club of Durban Bay (Marion Spence and Irene Kotze), and the Rotary Club of Shelton Skookum USA (John Hinck)...
