Ronald is seen receiving his award from Rotarian Barry Roberts.

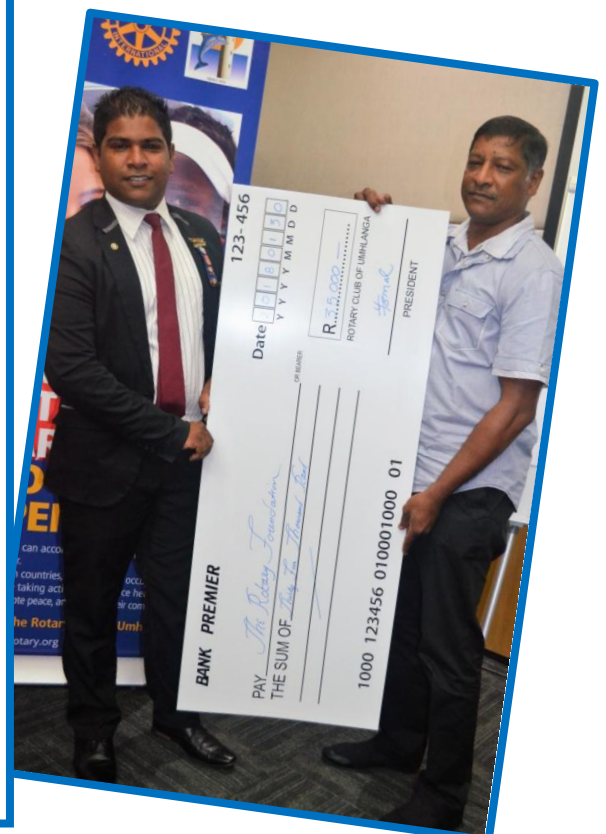


Rotary Foundation Cheque Handover

CYBERCRIME

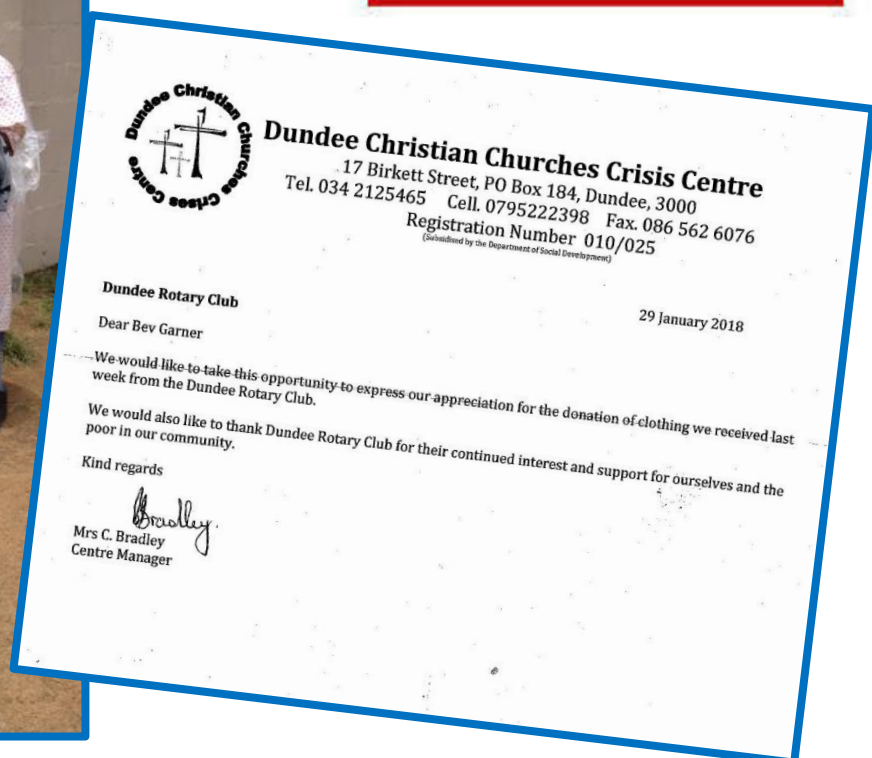
