Woza Moya and JAM SA

Following on a recent talk about community crèche project in Ifafa Valley, Rotarians Barry Roberts and Kerry Moss, introduced JAM SA to Woza Moya. JAM SA currently feed over 120,000 children at more than 2000 centers in 9 provinces across the country. They also distribute a million bowls of cereal to beneficiaries in Angola, South Sudan, Sierra Leone and Mozambique. Over the upcoming 90 days, JAM SA are rolling out the feeding scheme to the largest Woza Moya crèche, and from there to the outlying crèches. The aim is to feed 200 children in the Ifafa Valley at 11 crèches, a daily balanced meal that provides them with 75% of their daily macro/micro nutrient requirements.
