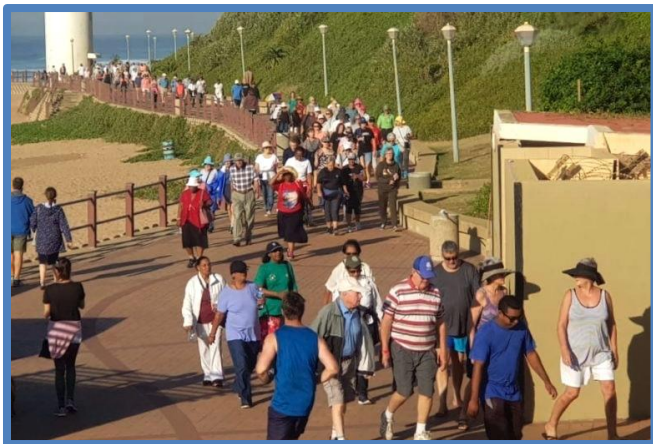

The seventh Gran 'n Gramps walk took place again along Umhlanga's glorious five kilometer promenade in perfect conditions. After months of planning by the Rotary working group, headed by Rotarian Clive Hull and his team, 345 enthusiastic walkers, from eleven retirement villages and 166 members of the public, walked to raise charity funds for distribution by the Rotary Club of Umhlanga. In addition to the walk, the walkers received coffee, breakfast and lucky dip prizes of huge hampers, vouchers and other goodies. Gifts of toiletries have been split between TAFTA and Verulam Day Care, whilst R20000 will go Happy Hours crèche for mentally handicapped children in Durban North. Thanks go to all involved who worked to stage the event, the Municipality, the UIP, medical services, churches, the media, 47 generous company and private sponsors, Rotarians from RCU, and all the participants who support the event each year.

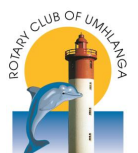


Gift of the Givers Foundation receives goods and food parcels
