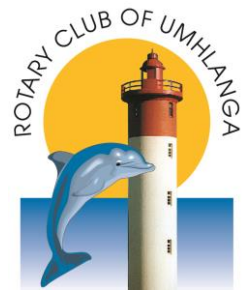

## Lakehaven Children's Home Gets A Makeover From Interact Club Of Crawford College La-Lucia



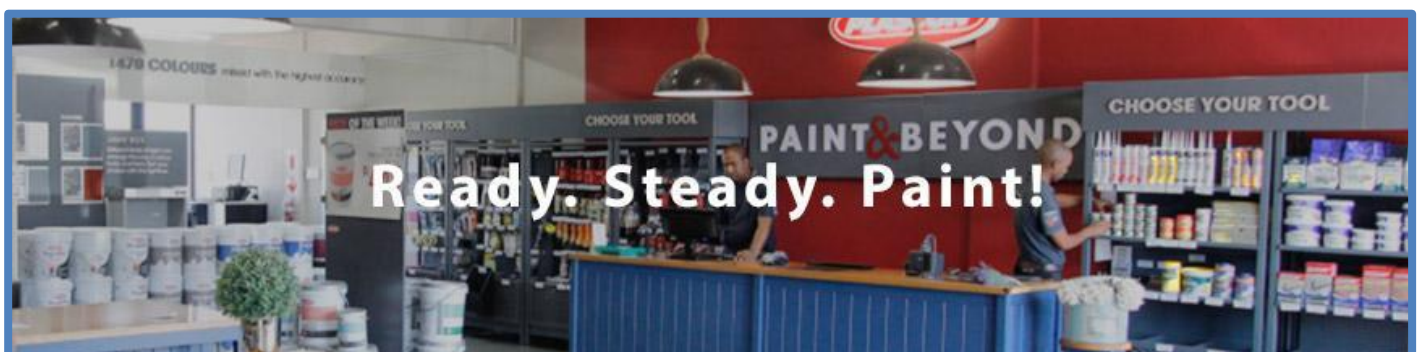

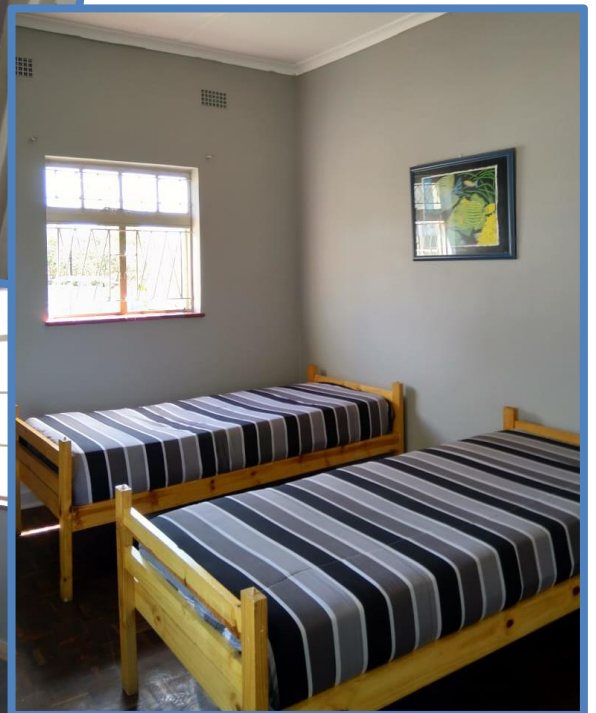
